HEF217 – Chefmaster Insect Trap

Safety Tips

- If you find any damage when the product is unpacked, contact your Chefmaster supplier within 24 hours of receipt of goods
- Repairs should always be carried out by a qualified technician
- Do not use this product outside
- Install out of reach of Children
- Install at least 1m away from food preparation areas
- Do not use near flammable objects
- Always switch off and unplug the unit before cleaning
- If the power cord becomes damaged it must be replaced by a qualified technician
- This product is not designed to be used by persons with reduced physical or mental capabilities, lack of experience or knowledge, unless they are given suitable supervision, this includes children.
- This product is designed for indoor use only.



Pack Contents

• 1 x Chefmaster Insect Trap with Glue Board

Before Use

- Remove all packaging including all protective plastic, from your Chefmaster Insect Trap
- For best results install your Insect Trap in the darkest part of the room, 1m way from any food preparation areas

Operation

- Plug in the Insect Trap
- The light will then come on to attract insects
- Switch off by unplugging the unit after use

Changing the UV-A tube or Glue Board



- Disconnect the Insect Trap from the electricity supply
- Lift up the front cover
- Remove UV-A Tube and replace if it has blown out OR
- Remove Glue Board and replace if it is full

Cleaning & Maintenance

- Disconnect the Insect Trap from the electricity supply before cleaning
- Clean the outer casing with damp cloth
- DO NOT submerge the Insect Trap in water or use water sprays to clean it

Do not store any flammable objects near the equipment.
